#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**



- 1. The entry Fee is \$20.00.
- Entry to consist of 4 commercial heifers (unregistered, 2020 drop) and must be displayed at the McIntosh & Son Mingenew Midwest Expo from 8am – 5pm Wednesday 11th & Thursday 12th August 2021.
  - a. Judging will commence at 9am
  - b. Placings will be announced on Wednesday 11th August 2021 (time TBC). All competitors are requested to be at the Elders Livestock Arena at that time for announcements and presentations.
  - c. It is considered beneficial to breeders to be present to hear judging comments on breeding, etc.
- 3. Open to grass fed heifers only.
- 4. Heifers from any breed or cross are eligible.
- 5. All heifers must be free from Brucellosis, TB, external parasites and contagious skin cancer.
- 6. Heifers must show milk teeth only.
- 7. Exhibitor to be from the Midwest Region of WA.
- 8. All cattle must come from a commercial herd, and owner bred. If the entrant also owns a registered stud it must be disclosed. (Bull calves and their mothers must be removed from the mob if breeding for your own use.)
- 9. Livestock delivery / pickup:
  - a. Stock pickup and delivery by Paul Starick Transport is available on request. If required, please indicate on your Entry Form.
  - b. Livestock **must be delivered to the Mingenew Recreation Grounds by 7.30am Wednesday 11th August 2021.** Entries will not be accepted after 8am.
  - c. Pens and loading ramps will be provided on the Expo grounds.
  - d. If the Livestock Steward is not available at the time of delivery, please ensure your NVD and any relevant paperwork is dropped in the collection box on site.
  - e. Trucks/vehicles are to be parked well away from the display area after unloading.
- 10. A National Vendor Declaration must be provided prior to displaying livestock at the show.

**IMPORTANT**: On your NVD where it states the Consignment to/Destination please ensure you write: **Mingenew Midwest Expo, Mingenew Recreation Grounds AND RETURN 12/8/21** 

- 11. All entrants are to supply breeding aims and objectives ATTACHED.
- 12. Animal welfare: the owner will
  - a. need to supply their own feed and water container (water available on site).
  - b. be responsible for the welfare and care of their animals throughout the event.
  - c. be responsible for the attitude of their animals in a public arena.
  - d. not wash cattle down in the display pen.
- 13. In the event the 2021 Heifer Competition receives more than 10 nominations, on farm judging may take place.
- 14. The judge and/or committee's decision will be final.
